

Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, in reference to the Stockholm Convention, consolidated with amendments.

Dear Customer,

On July 15, 2019 the Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 ("POPs Recast Regulation") came into force and is replacing Regulation (EC) 850/2004 and the various amendments made to this Regulation in the past few years.

On October 17, 2024 a new consolidated version of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 was published which incorporates the various amendments made to this legislation since July 2019.

DAFA Group A/S, as a supplier of foam and rubber products and solutions, is aware of the responsibilities of protecting the environment and human health. Based on the verified information, we announce that our products comply with the POPs Regulation and do not contain substances subject to prohibitions listed in Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, as amended. We continue to follow the POPs regulation update and ensure our products' conformity.
